ROLE OF CHILD PROTECTION OFFICER

A Club Children's Officer should be child centred in focus and have as the primary aim the establishment of a child centred ethos within the club. She/he is the link between the children and the adults in the club. She/he also takes responsibility for monitoring and reporting to the Club Management Committee on how club policy impacts on young people in the club.

A person appointed to the Club Children's Officer position in the club must

1. Complete Safeguarding Course 1
2. Complete Safeguarding Course 2
3. Be Garda Vetted with CWLTC

This Safeguarding 2 Children's Officer Training course will help the Club Children's Officer to carry out the function of their role in the club and support the implementation of best practice in the club.
