ROLE OF THE DESIGNATED LIAISON PERSON

The designated liaison person is responsible for ensuring that the standard reporting procedure is followed, so that suspected cases of child neglect or abuse are referred promptly to the Child and Family Agency Duty Social Worker – Tusla.

A person appointed to the Club DLP position in a club must:

1. Be Garda Vetted with CWLTC and
2. Complete Safeguarding 1 Course
3. Complete Safeguarding 3 Course

CWLTC may appoint the same person to both the Child Protection Officer and Designated Liaison Person positions however best practice advises that they are kept as separate role.
