Junior and Senior Championship, League, Tournament (Competitive and Social) matches take precedence over all other stated availability of courts. The General Committee from time to time may also place bookings in the calendar for community outreach programmes/local school collaborations etc. These also take precedence over all other stated availability.

Senior & Junior League Fixtures

As league matches must be completed, any court booking immediately after a scheduled league fixture is not guaranteed at the exact booked time.

League matches being played on the front courts - If a league match is underway on one of the front courts, the adjacent court must remain unused. For example, if a match is in progress on Court 1 and both Courts 2 and 3 are free, only Court 3 may be used. Similarly, if a match is being played on Court 2, both Courts 1 and 3 are unavailable until the match on Court 2 concludes.

Coaching Rights

Outside of 'Senior Only Hours' coaching has priority on four courts for group and private coaching Monday to Friday and on three courts on Saturdays. The Head Coach has the right to pre-book courts for group and private coaching.

Court 6 will be considered the Coaching Court for private lessons and can be pre-booked by any member of the coaching team. The Head Coach has discretion over the Senior players availing of coaching in **Senior Only Hours**, and League Playing Juniors and Juniors who have represented Ireland in the preceding calendar year can be coached during **Senior Only Hours**. Coaching can take place on all other courts during **Senior Only Hours**; however, the booking must conform to the court booking rules (ie 5 Days in advance, when the time slot opens).

The Tennis Committee retains the right to approve all coaching groups and individuals.

***League Playing Juniors have Senior rights on court during Senior Only Hours**

A junior is considered a League Playing Junior if within the calendar year they are selected for any team for a minimum of two Adult League campaigns. They are given Senior booking rights during the first campaign (Winter League) and the rights are removed at the start of Floodlit leagues if they do not play Summer or Floodlit leagues. The Tennis Committee is taking into consideration the difficulty of playing Summer League and completing school exams.
